

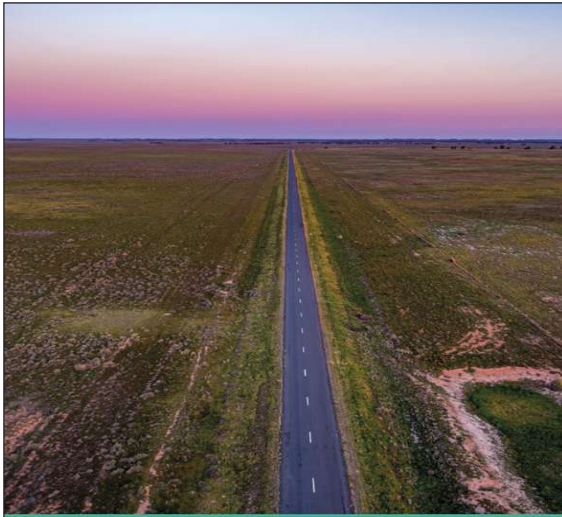

The Hay Economic Transition Roadmap builds on the foundational work by applying a focused lens to the regional economy as the key system through which resilience and prosperity are created. The Roadmap provides a framework to guide the region through economic change in a way that is locally led, coordinated and aligned with community values. Rather than responding reactively to change, the Roadmap seeks to ensure the community is actively shaping the future economy of the region, positioning Hay to capture the benefits of emerging industries while protecting its landscapes, culture and way of life. The Roadmap therefore acts as the bridge between the long-term resilience vision established in the Drought Resilience Plan and the practical economic actions required to deliver that vision. At the Match Ordinary meeting, Council adopted the "Shaping Hay's Future - a 10 Year Economic Transition Roadmap and supported the development of the Economic Transition Roadmap 'Hay Futures Playbook' and progression of the "Accelerator Actions".

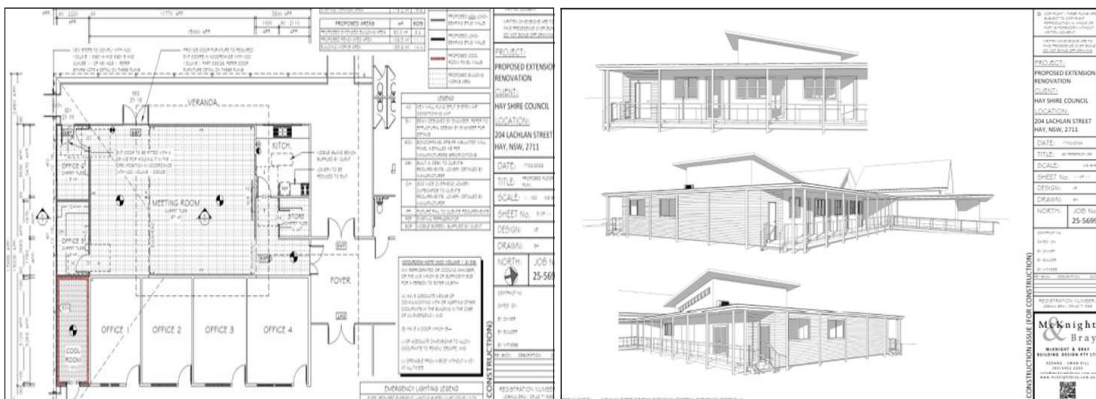

Hay Heavy Vehicle Rest Area and Hay Aerodrome Heavy Vehicle Entrance Projects

At its March Ordinary meeting, Council resolved to award Contracts and proceed with the construction of the Hay Heavy Vehicle Rest Area and Hay Aerodrome Heavy Vehicle Entrance projects. Both projects have received significant federal government grant funding and are anticipated to commence within the next few weeks. They will improve community safety and freight transport efficiency.



Updated Opening Hours - John Houston Memorial Swimming Pool

Hay Shire Council wishes to advise the community of updated operating arrangements for the John Houston Memorial Swimming Pool as the season draws to a close.

Unsupervised access to the pool has now been introduced. Access is available via a FOB system, with FOBs being acquired for a refundable deposit of \$20 per FOB (Limit of one per family). FOBs can be obtained from Council's Administration Building or by completing an on-line application on our website.

Unsupervised Access Hours: 8.00am - 2.00pm daily
Supervised Access Hours: 3.00pm - 6.00pm
Splash Park 8.00am - 8.00pm daily

The swimming pool will officially close for the season on Sunday, 26 April 2026 with the Splash Park closing on Sunday, 10 May 2026.

Council thanks the community for its continued support and encourages residents to make the most of the facility over the remaining weeks of the season.
